As your Supervisor of Elections for Pasco County, it is my obligation to run transparent, impartial and trouble free elections. I would like to take this opportunity to thank my staff, the 1,000 + pollworkers and the Adopt-A-Precinct partners who once again rose to the challenge for the Presidential Preference Primary on January 29, 2008 and continued Pasco's tradition of excellence with elections administration.

We are now preparing for Pasco's Municipal elections scheduled for April 8, 2008, as well as the much anticipated August primary and November General. My staff and I work year round on Voter Education and Outreach in the community. Our goal is to make each voter an informed voter.

I urge all citizens of Pasco County to be informed by registering to vote or if already registered, by keeping your voter registration up to date. The responsibility of each voter does not end with registering and voting. Voters must keep their registrations in good standing by updating address changes, signature updates and party changes.

By law, Florida is a closed primary state. Party changes must be made before book closing which, per Florida Statute, is 29 days before each election. Any party changes made after book closing will be accepted in the Supervisor's office and changed for the next eligible election. Address changes and signature updates can be made after bookclosing.

Anyone making changes to their voter registration will automatically receive an updated voter information card in the mail, to the address we have on file, within a few weeks of the change. If you have not received your new card, please give my office a call. Voter information cards supply voters with their polling place, party affiliation among other information.

As the Supervisor of Elections, I urge everyone to ensure their voter registrations are up to date before the next primary.
