On-line Training Platform (OTP)

Don't forget to complete your mandatory on-line training course (OTP)! You must complete the OTP in order to be eligible to work the fall elections. Training letters for task-specific trainings will be mailed in June to available workers who have completed the on-line training platform.

Training Dates 2010 Fall Election Cycle

The Pollworker Training Calendar for the fall election cycle has been completed. The following dates are for "task-specific" trainings. Prior to each election, pollworkers will be required to attend ONE of the task-specific trainings for their assigned position. NEW EViD Operators and Voting System Specialists (VSS) are the exception. New EViD and VSS personnel will attend two hands-on classes prior to the Primary Election on August 24, 2010. Remember: you must complete your on-line training course in order to be eligible to attend a task-specific training. Please direct all questions regarding the training schedule to your pollworker coordinator as soon as possible.

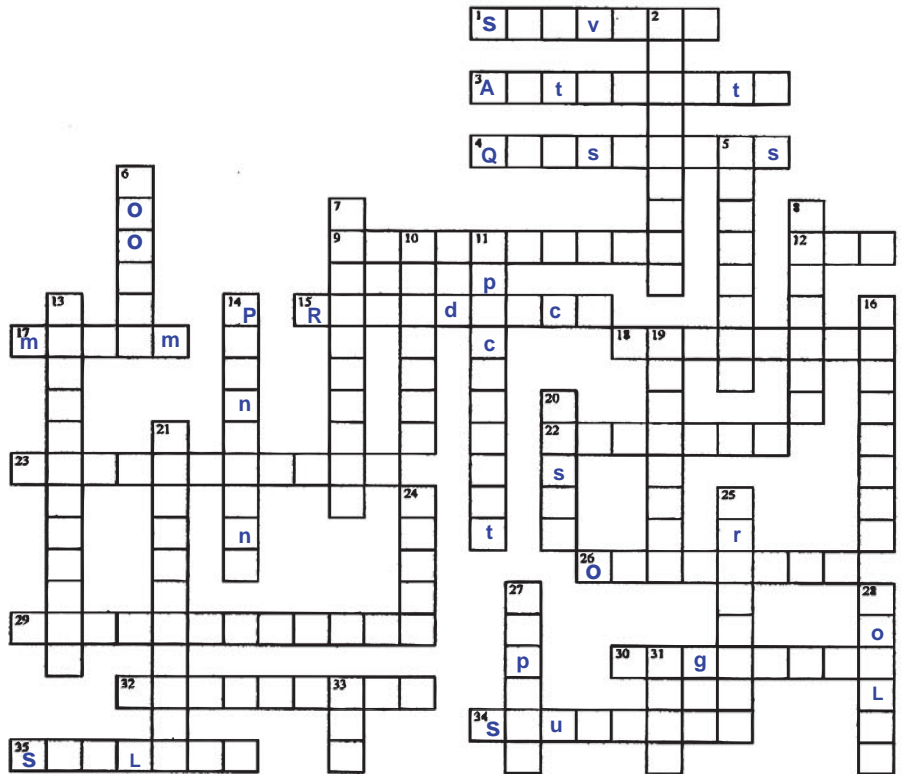
Poll Worker Puzzle
