## **Important Information To Help You Prepare**

- Municipal elections are only for voters residing within the city proper. Your residence must be within the limits/boundaries of the city.
- If you have moved into or within the city limits, update your address prior to Election Day by calling **800-851-8754**, or use the online address change form at **www.pascovotes.com**.
- If you have not voted recently, you should check your voter registration status on-line at [www.pascovotes.com](http://www.pascovotes.com), or call our office 1-800-851-8754.
- Utilize your sample ballot and research the candidates. Sample ballots will be published in *Tampa Bay Times* and are available at [www.pascovotes.com](http://www.pascovotes.com).
- Know your polling location in advance. For municipal elections only all precincts within each city limit use the same polling location. See [www.pascovotes.com](http://www.pascovotes.com) for a complete list or call 1-800-851-8754.
- Take your photo and signature ID to the polls. See [www.pascovotes.com](http://www.pascovotes.com) for a list of acceptable forms of identification.
- Vote-by-mail ballots are available for the Municipal Election. Request yours at [www.pascovotes.com](http://www.pascovotes.com) or call 800-851-8754. Ballots are also available at city halls beginning March 10th.
